COVID19 Policies and Consent

As a patient of Unity Acupuncture, I understand that I am being treated during a pandemic.

I understand that there is risk involved in being in the clinic and in proximity of other people. Although social/physical distancing measures and precautions are being followed, I understand that there is still a chance for exposure.

I agree to comply with the safety measures that Unity Community Acupuncture has in place. I understand that these measures are for my safety as well as the safety of others. Therefore, I understand that:

- No more than 10 people will be allowed into the clinic at one time, including staff.
- I may not enter the clinic early for my appointment, instead I must wait outside the clinic or in my vehicle until my appointment time.
- I must wear a mask at all times when I am inside the office. If I do not have a mask, one will be provided to me for no less than \$2.
- I will have my temperature taken by clinician before coming into the office.
- I must wash or sanitize my hands upon entry. I will wait to receive a pump of hand sanitizer before touching anything or I will go to the bathroom where I will wash my hands.
- I will be asked if I have or have had any signs and symptoms of illness: Fever, respiratory issues (cough), or have I had the illness or have I been in contact with someone who has. If I answer yes, then I understand that:
 - My appointment will be canceled immediately,
 - I will be charged for the appointment,
 - I will be given information on COVID19 testing sites
 - And I will be asked to wait 14-21 days before making another appointment with Unity Acupuncture.
- I will be directed to a treatment station and receive treatment in the sanitized treatment room.
- After the treatment I am expected to leave as promptly as possible.
- Cash and check payments are discouraged at this time, we prefer contact-less electronic payment methods.
- If needed, I can have a follow-up phone call by a Unity staff member.
- If I need to talk with a staff member, however, I must stand behind the lines marked on the floor for proper distancing.

- If I do become infected within 14 days of my treatment, then I will contact Unity Community Acupuncture know as soon as possible to inform them.
- If someone at Unity Community Acupuncture has become infected during a time when I was also receiving a treatment, then they will contact me as soon as possible.
